Kerkini is a dam lake, created in 1932 and the main water provider is Strymonas river. It is recouped by the International Convention of Ramsar and hosts thousands of birds, both rare and protected, riverside forests, water-lilies in a large area, a wide fish, amphibian and mammalian variety. More than 300 bird species have been recorder, especially non-migrating, 76 of which are included in the National Red Catalogue, while at least 31 of them are protected by EEC Birds Directive. What makes an exceptional presence is the buffalo's herd in the area of Kerkini lake. In the surrounding area, there are at least 10 amphibian species (frogs, salamanders, tritons), 5 snail species, 19 reptile species (lizards, snakes, turtles) and a great variety of insects which play an important part in the food chain and contribute towards the biological resources of the lake.
